

PLA Credit Recommendation Guide

Evaluation Summary for Sheetz

The University of Arizona Global Campus (UAGC) recognizes the uniqueness of each student's experience and realizes learning takes place in a variety of environments. The UAGC Prior Learning Assessment (PLA) program provides a means for awarding credit to students who bring college-level learning experiences acquired outside of a traditional university classroom setting, and which do not carry national testing program, American Council on Education (ACE), and/or National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCCRS) credit recommendation(s).

Specific Sheetz trainings have been evaluated by the PLA Department, and credit recommendations have been determined. The recommendations listed below are based on the training as taught on the date of transfer guide creation and do not constitute a guarantee that credit will be awarded. Students must follow the Sponsored Professional Training process. All decisions on awarding PLA credit are made by Faculty subject-matter experts. Any variation in previous or subsequent training versions may carry different credit recommendations.

Student Eligibility for PLA

To pursue PLA credit, students must be admitted to an eligible degree program at UAGC and have their official transfer credit evaluation completed. PLA credit may only be pursued when approval of PLA credits will fulfill unique remaining requirement(s) for graduation for the student.

Students are responsible for:

- Discussing PLA with their Academic Advisor.
- Reviewing the PLA Information Center located in myUAGC > MyUAGC Essentials > My Account > My Degree.
- Submitting the required documentation.
- Submitting a PLA Credit Review Application, upon request.

Transfer Provisions

The transferability of credits is subject to the University of Arizona Global Campus transfer credit policies and requires the submission of official transcripts. The official transcripts will be evaluated by the Office of the Registrar to determine

the credits that will officially apply toward a UAGC degree program. PLA credit may be pursued once the official transcript evaluation is complete. Credits must be earned at the same degree level in order to be applied. The PLA option is not available to non-degree seeking students or to students in specific graduate degree programs.
