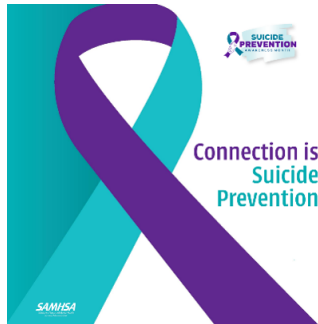

UAGC Spirit Week | October 19-24, 2026

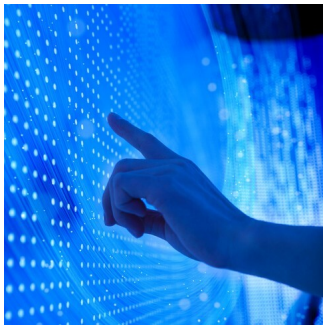

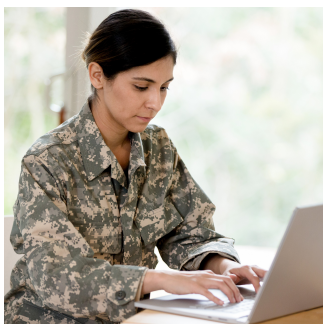


UAGC Psych Club | Q1 Coffee Klatch Examining Aileen Wournous
